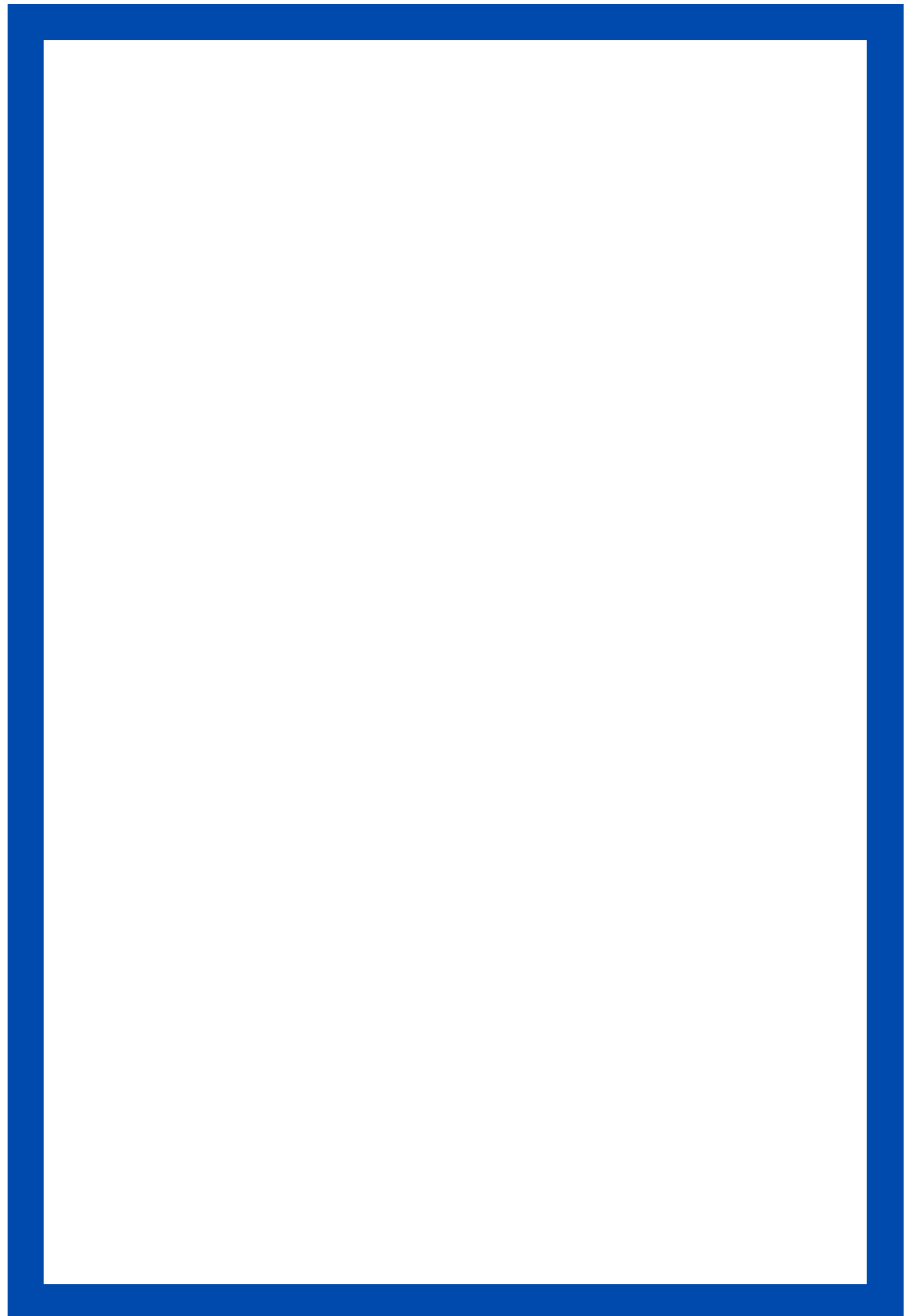

Shem, Ham & Japheth



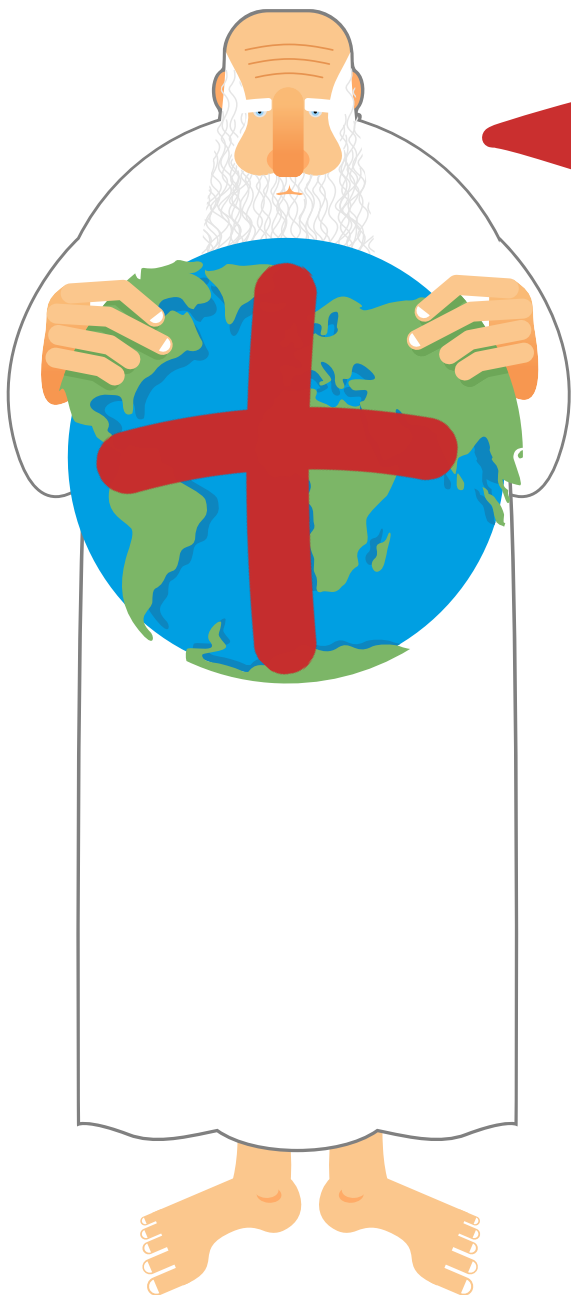

“I am going to put an end to all people, for the earth is filled with violence because of them. I am surely going to destroy both them and the earth.”



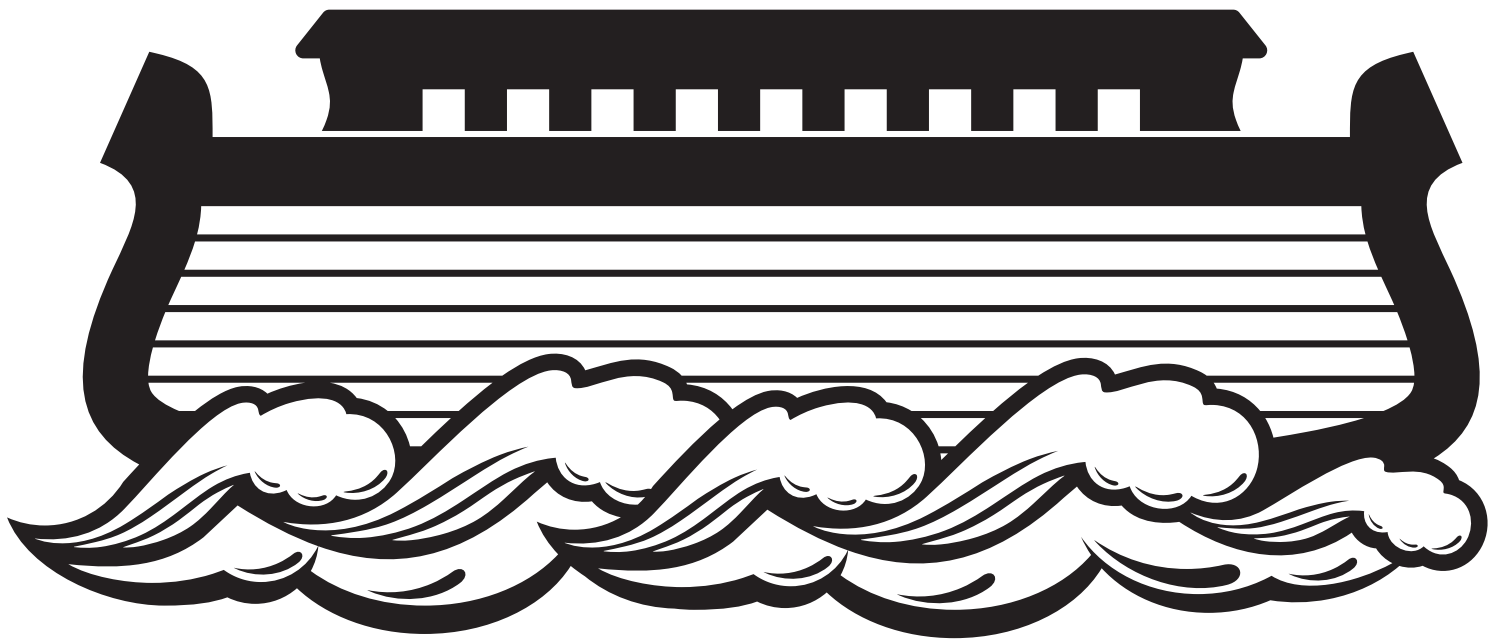

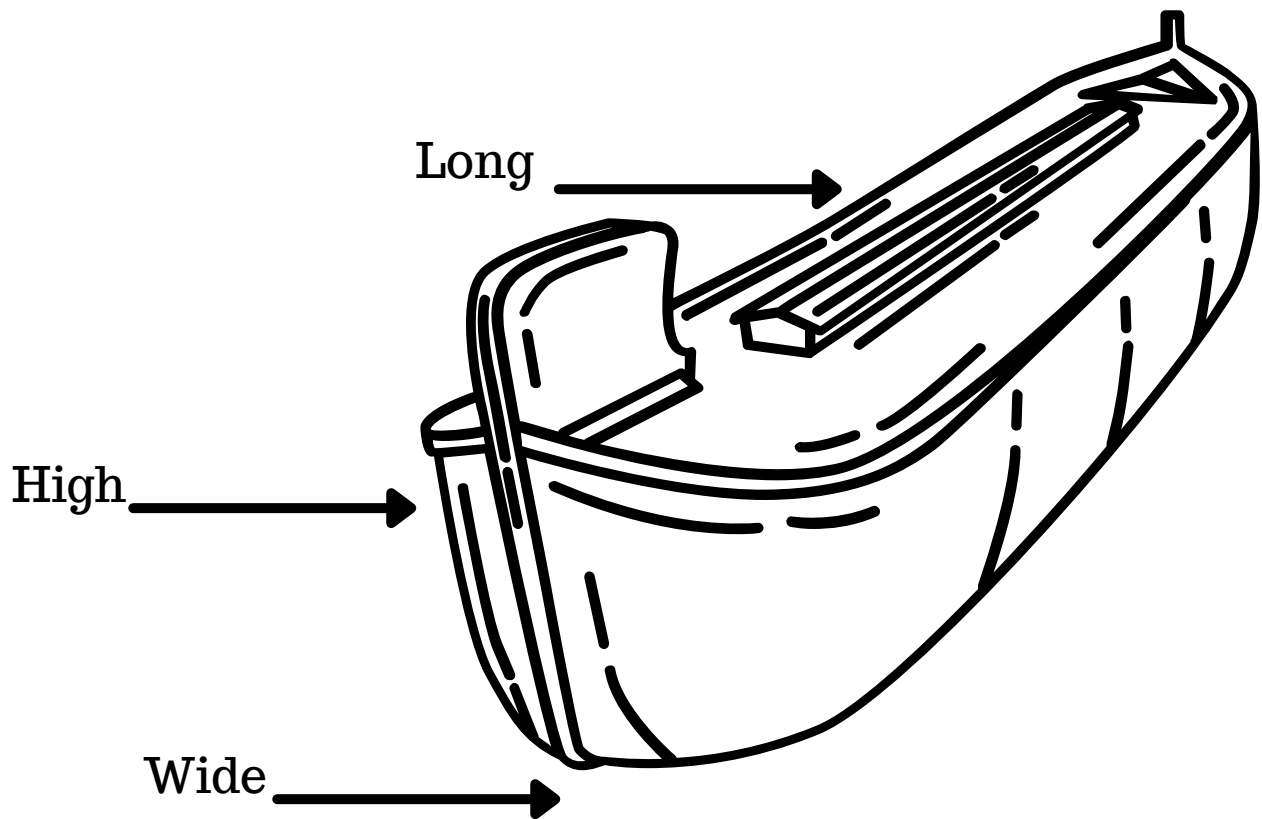

God gave Noah specific measurements when He told him how to build the ark. Those were perfect measurements that were required to keep Noah, his family and all the animals safe during their journey.

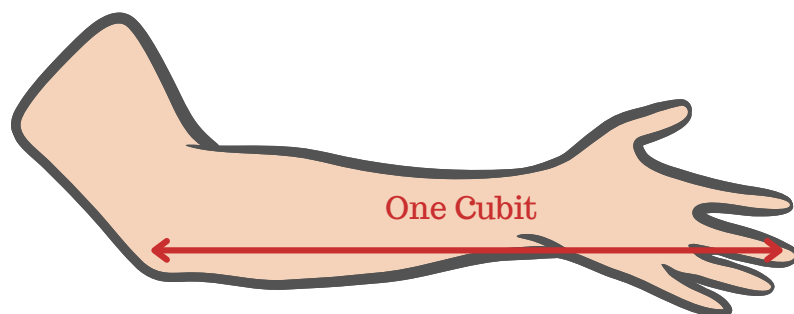

17 I am going to bring floodwaters on the earth to destroy all life under the heavens, every creature that has the breath of life in it.

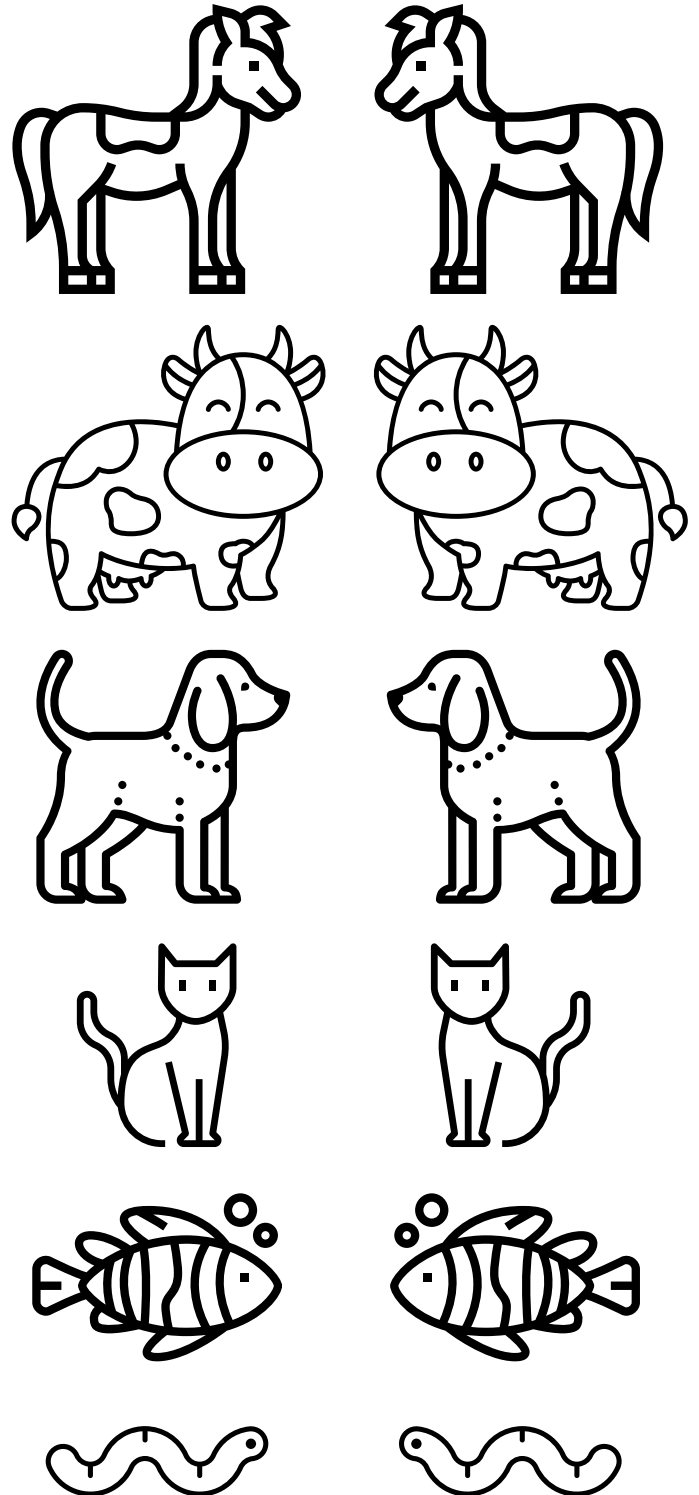
Everything on earth will perish.
