Jeremiah 31:3

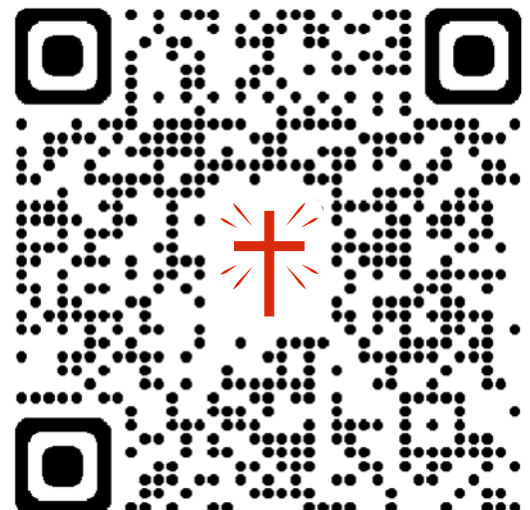
First. He loved you first, and forever. He knows all about you from the beginning of time and is waiting to hear you say you believe that He is the Son of God.
