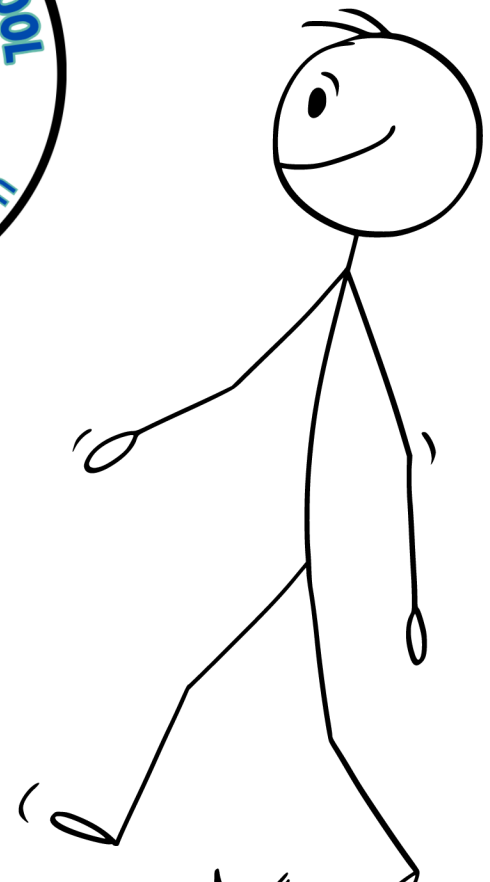
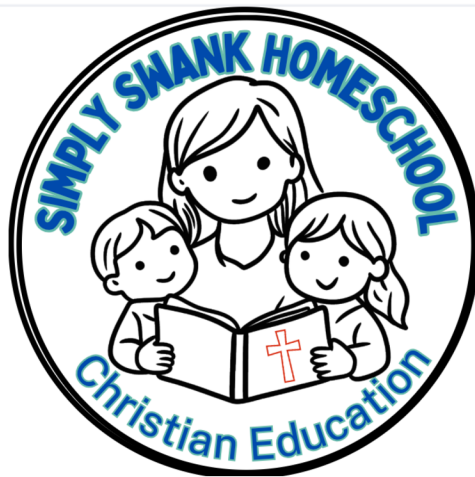

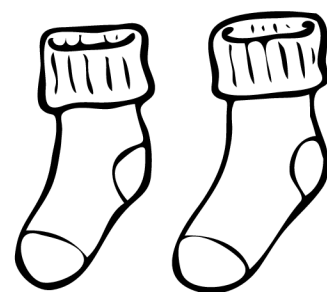
As I read through my favorite book, the Bible, I was curious about the life of Elijah. I prayed, “Lord, help me know this man better and help me understand what You did through him.”

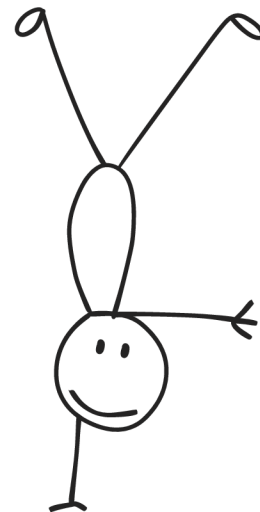




How to use this book:

- ask Him to allow you to know and grow in your relationship with Him.

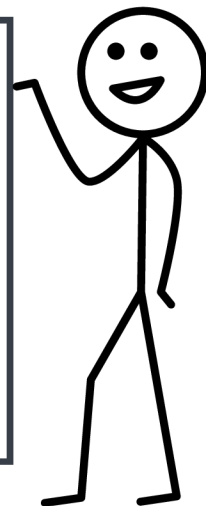

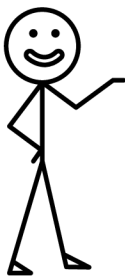

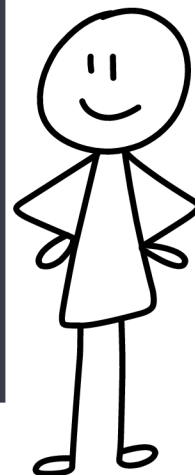

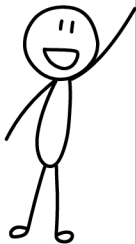
Elijah outruns chariot - 8 miles

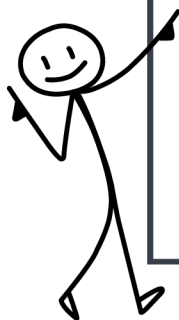

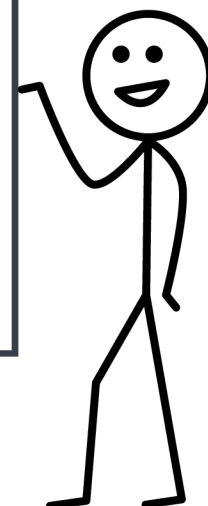

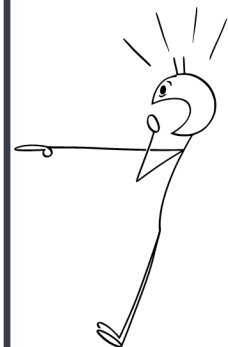

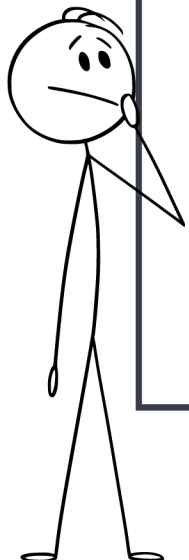

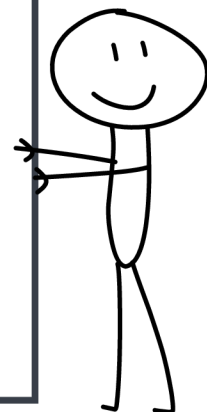

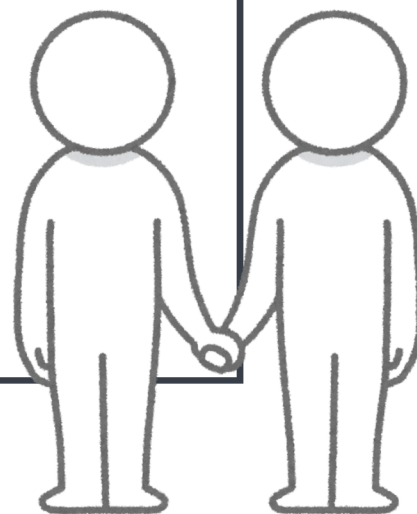
